

Waste sorting guide

In Langeland Kommune we sort our waste in order to recycle as much as possible. We strive to reuse the valuable resources from household waste.

The better you sort your waste, the better we can recycle and reuse.

This sorting guide concerns biowaste, non-recyclable waste, cardboard and paper.

We collect biowaste/non-recyclable waste and cardboard/paper at your property or at your assigned waste station.



Leftovers (raw or processed)
Fruit and vegetables
Rice and pasta
Fat and sauce
Cheese and cold cuts
Fish, meat and bones
Eggs and eggshells
Bread and pastries
Kitchen roll from the kitchen
Coffee grounds, Tea and Filter
Cut-off flowers

When sorting biowaste, please place it in a thin plastic bag. Please tie a knot on the bag before placing it in the biowaste bin.



Plastic food trays and packaging
Cartons from e.g. milk or juice
Nappies, sanitary towels, cotton buds, etc.
Tin foil
Disposable tableware
Vacuum cleaner bags and ashes (must be extra packed)
Pet waste
Wrapping paper and ribbons
Pizza trays
Chips bags
Pot scourer
Cigarette butts
Bags from candy and frozen foods



Newspapers and advertisements
Printer paper
Envelopes and letters
Magazines and weeklies
Cartoon books
Soft bag books
Cardboard and paperboard
Egg cartons (clean)
Cardboard pipes from kitchen- and toilet roll
Cardboard packaging from breakfast products, toothpaste etc.

You can hand in used batteries in a transparent plastic bag and place it at the lid of your waste bin.
We receive glass, metals, electronic waste, and all other types of waste at our recycling centres.
